



Academic and Personal Standards

The mission of Queen of Angels Academy is to promote the academic success and personal well-being of each student. Specifically, the Academy's mission is to provide educational excellence, rooted in the Catholic tradition, for students who are committed to the school community as well as to their own personal achievement.

The commitment of each student to her own achievement is absolutely central to the outcome of her QAA experience.

This is why each QAA student will, as her normal and daily routine:

- Demonstrate real effort and attention in each and every class, with obvious cooperation, politeness and active participation. (Every course she is registered in “counts” – she is expected to pass them all.)
- Demonstrate consistent and unflagging respect for herself, her peers, and all adults within the QAA community.
- Commit to and schedule herself for a couple of hours of homework (written, projects, studying, re-reading, etc.) every evening.
- Prepare carefully for every quiz, test, and oral presentation so that her best work is visible at all times, to peers and teachers alike.
- Honour each assignment deadline as a matter of course and personal pride.
- Persevere in challenging situations with total honesty.
- Attend any tutoring sessions provided by teachers, if required.
- Accept outside tutoring help if recommended by teachers.
- Demonstrate respect for school cleanliness and the good repair of furnishings made available for her.
- Avoid at all costs being a disruptive or negative influence in any class.

Chronic infringement of the norms and/or flagrantly inappropriate behaviour by a student will result in the student being asked to withdraw from the Academy or in having her registration for the following year refused.
