Disciplinary actions include

(not necessarily in sequential order):

- Warnings
- Detentions
- In- or out-of-school suspensions
- Expulsion

Guidelines for good behaviour

- The underlying principle of social behaviour is respect (for self, others, and surroundings).
- Appropriate student behaviour is necessary to create a positive, pleasant and safe environment for all.
- Students are to assume personal responsibility for their behaviour, whether on QAA grounds or in public while recognizable as a QAA student.
- Students are to display appropriate self-control and self-discipline and accept the consequences of inappropriate behaviour.
- Appropriate behaviour from students extends to school-sponsored events, field trips, ski trips, and dances.
- Students are responsible for any guests' behaviour while they are on QAA premises or at QAA-sponsored events.
- Students may not attend dances or events while under the influence of any behaviour-altering substance.
- Persistent infringement of the norms and/or flagrantly inappropriate behaviour by a student will result in a meeting with that student's parents and she could be asked to withdraw from the school immediately or not have her academic contract renewed.
