

Electronic Devices



QAA acknowledges that parents might have purchased any number of digital or electronic devices for their daughter, for very valid reasons.

It is forbidden, however, for students to use any such communication/recording/playback device at any time of the school day, anywhere on the property, from 7 am to 3 pm, including recess and lunch.

- Students do NOT need a phone to receive messages during the school day. *To change a carpool arrangement, for example, please call Reception and the student will be given the message.*

Parents:

Checking your monthly statement is a good way to see your daughter's record of phone activity.

Use of pay phones for emergency calls

During recess or lunch, students are permitted to use the pay phones but must limit their calls to 2 to 3 minutes to allow for the maximum number of students to have access.

- Students do NOT need a phone in case of illness or a change of plans. *If a difficulty arises, students must inform a member of the staff (usually the secretarial office) who will assist in calling a parent, if necessary.*
- Students must leave any electronic and/or digital device that is in their possession in their locker immediately upon arrival at school and can regain possession only after 3:00 pm.

Please read the Acceptable Use Policy which both parent and daughter are asked to sign annually. It is part of the contract with Queen of Angels.

Failure to comply with QAA's policy will result in the device being confiscated. See *Computer & Internet Use*, page 15, for more on this topic.
