

Field Trips



Student participation is mandatory in all same-day field trips, special events and retreats, since these are integral to the Academy's total curriculum, as agreed to in the signed contract with QAA.

Each field trip will **always** be preceded by an informational memo sent home with the student before the event.

QAA standard dress-code rules remain in effect for same-day field trips.

Barring illness or other emergency, each student's presence for all same-day field trips, special activity days, liturgies and retreat days is compulsory. Compliance is part of your signed contract with QAA.

Senior Field Trips

QAA offers several special optional events during the school year to senior students such as the cotillion dance, trips to Stratford, Europe, and New York and the Mont Sainte-Anne ski weekend.

The Academy reserves the right to disallow any student applications for these events when the conduct or demeanor of a student suggests that she could pose an unnecessary additional burden of responsibility on the supervisors of such events.

If, in the course of her time at QAA, a student has given evidence of poor personal judgment, marked immaturity, habitual negativity, unreliability, fractious peer relationships, disrespect, or chronic indifference to her academic effort, she will not be included in these special events.

In this matter, the decision of the Academy is final.

In the same way, if a student has personal/attitudinal issues which could result in unpleasant tensions within the group or become an emergency, the student's family is asked NOT to apply for the event.

The Academy must weigh the wishes of the individual student against the foreseeable impact on the common good.
