Honour Roll

For work done in 2010-2011 and beyond, an 80.0% general average is required. This average will include all subjects on the student's course list (except *Français, langue d'enseignement* if that mark lowers the general average).

Award certificates for Honour Roll are presented at a special evening ceremony in October.

Principal's List

The students who have received the five highest averages in their grade level are placed on the Principal's List. Special recognitions are presented at the Honour Roll ceremony.

Honour Society membership is granted when a graduating student's five-year average meets Honour Roll criteria. A student does not need to have been on Honour Roll for each of her QAA years but has to have a five-year summary average based on the minimums for each year. This average will include all subjects on the student's course list (except *Français, langue d'enseignement*, if that mark lowers her general average).

For work done in 2010-2011 and beyond, an 80.0% general average is the QAA Honour Roll minimum.

Honour Society calculations are based on a combination average of the MELS competency years and the QAA years.

Consideration is given to a student who attended a comparable educational institution elsewhere for some of her years and who maintained an equivalent standard of academic excellence. However, in such cases, only the grades obtained at QAA are used in determining the final average.
