

Report Cards



Formal parent/teacher interviews are held after the first two reporting sessions. If a parent does not receive a request to meet with the teacher(s), attendance at parent/teacher interviews is optional.

Parents can contact teachers at any time to discuss any concerns.

Report cards are sent home regularly throughout the year. They are given to the students to bring home on the dates listed on the academic calendar. Parents are asked to take note of these dates and look for the envelope when their daughter arrives home.

Summer support, in certain cases, will be required in order for a student to continue her studies at the Academy. It may also be strongly suggested, though not required. It is meant to provide students in difficulty with supplementary opportunities to develop the courses or competencies with which they are struggling. It should be seen as an opportunity for success.

In Year 5, a student who fails a course may wish to first consult the CEGEP

she is planning to attend next fall, which may be able to provide some alternatives other than summer support.

Summer classes are held at a variety of locations around Montreal, and subjects vary from year to year. QAA provides a list of summer courses at Loyola in May, but all public school board or private learning centre programs are equally acceptable.
