MANDATORY STANDARD UNIFORM

FOR CLASSROOM AND FIELD TRIPS

- Kilt
- QAA embroidered white fitted blouse (short or long sleeves)
- Black Dress Jacket
- Black tights or knee socks
- Tartan tie
- Black school shoes

Returning students may continue to wear green uniform pieces at QAA while Piacente supplies last.

Additional optional pieces:

- Polartech soft shell (not to be worn inside school; for travel to and from school only)
- Black dress pants (can be worn all year)
- Long- or short-sleeved polo shirts
- Black sleeveless vest

FOR PHYS-ED AND RETREATS

- QAA T-shirt and/or QAAhoodie
- Navy QAA jogging pants or plain navy shorts
- White calf or knee socks
- Supportive running shoes

Please be sure to purchase enough socks and blouses for a fresh look every day.

The QAA dress code requires students to arrive and leave the school in perfect uniform.

Don't need to try something on? Just order it online!

Student attire must always be neat, clean, and in good repair.

If necessary, the student will be asked to purchase a new uniform item.

DRESS CODE

Clothing should be clean, ironed, in good repair and fit properly. Students are required to travel to and from school in their regular uniform – with the added permission of substituting official QAA club or sportswear, and exterior footwear. Flip-flops are not acceptable at any time of the year!

UNIFORM RULES

- Kilt hems must not be more than 10 cm (4 inches) above the knee.
- Subtle makeup is permitted.
- Nail polish is permitted with the exception of black.
- Two small earrings may be worn on each ear.
- No visible body piercings or tattoos.
- Hair accessories should be plain in design.
- Hair should be neat and clean at all times. Unconventional styles and colours are not permitted.
- Students must have their hair tied back while in the labs and in all physical education activities.
- The official Phys. Ed. uniform must be worn for Phys. Ed. classes.
- The black blazer (Sec. 1-4) and tie must be worn for all formal outings and special assemblies.

Students are QAA ambassadors, easily recognized by the public. A good appearance enhances the whole person and indicates a respectful attitude towards oneself and others.

New shoes usually have to be purchased each year.

Expect to buy a new kilt in Year 3.

The school uniform is to be worn so that everyone associated with the Academy can take pride in our school and in the student's appearance.
