FOR GRADE 7 STUDENTS - FALL 2009

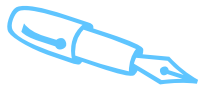


## WHAT IS THE NEW COMMON ADMISSION TEST (CAT)?

Six QAIS schools (Lower Canada College, Miss Edgar's and Miss Cramp's School, Queen of Angels Academy, Selwyn House School, St. George's School of Montreal and The Study) are simplifying their admission testing procedure for Grade 7 applicants. The new QAIS Common Admission Test (CAT) is:

- compatible with Quebec Education Reform, reflecting a student's potential
- based on Canadian content
- shorter
- more student-friendly

The new standardized test contains three sections: non-verbal aptitude, mathematics, and English-language reading and writing skills. French-language skills are assessed separately according to each school's requirements. The test is administered by Brisson Legris, a Quebec-based testing service.

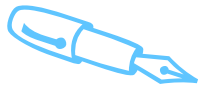


## WHERE WILL THE TEST BE HELD?

## HOW TO REGISTER FOR THE TEST

Parents must apply directly to the school(s) of their choice. In addition to completing the school's application form, parents should register online for the Common Admission Test (CAT) at **[www.registrationbl.qc.ca](http://www.registrationbl.qc.ca)**. The registration fee is \$75, payable by cash (exact amount only) or money order, payable to Brisson Legris, at the test site.
